HOW YOUR REGULAR DONATIONS ARE USED

Regular, ongoing donations are used to fund many of the general costs of our work that aren't covered by our government funding – including things like:

- Equipment like stretchers, defibrillators and other lifesaving equipment our paramedics need.
- Paying for essential costs of our service like vehicle maintenance, fuel, station maintenance costs – providing our paramedics with the resources they need.
- Infrastructure that supports our entire team in the community- like stations, IT equipment, etc.



Regular donations help to fund



Fully kitted out Critical Care vehicles. These essential vehicles provide specialist medicines and emergency response, wherever an emergency ambulance crew may be. Costs include:

- All medical equipment
- Customised storage and fit-out
- Lights and sirens
- Wellington Free livery



Blood glucose monitor to measure blood sugar
- \$40



An electronic thermometer, used with almost every patient
- \$400



Used in 98% of call outs, Corpuls defibrillators are essential - \$35,000



Powered stretchers help keep our people and our patients safe
- \$56,000

The impact of regular, ongoing donations

Each year we must raise over \$9.5 million from the community to ensure we can be here when people need us most, free of charge – your regular and ongoing donations form a crucial part of this.

Your regular and ongoing donations are used to provide essential healthcare services, including our Emergency Ambulance Service.

An emergency ambulance call-out, on average, costs **\$650**.

Last financial year, regular and ongoing givers donated around \$820,000 – that's the equivalent of approximately 1,260 emergency ambulance callouts. These donations have helped us to maintain our ability to keep our services free of charge for our communities. Ensuring there are no financial barriers to accessing emergency healthcare is a founding value we're proud to maintain almost 100 years since Wellington Free was founded. Regular, ongoing donors play a big part in making this possible.
